

WSCGA Membership and Status Types

Beginning January 1, 2010, WSCGA now has three member types:

R – Regular

H – Handicap Only

J – Junior (18 and under)

Regular members include club members who belong to the club and the women's club. Only Regular members can participate in WSCGA tournaments and team play.

Annual individual membership dues are \$30.

Handicap Only includes members, employees, and daughters of members over 18 who do not belong to the women's club but belong or have an affiliation with the club. Handicap Only members are not eligible to participate in WSCGA tournaments or team play although they can play in the Women's Golf Council (Saturday) events. Annual individual membership dues are \$30

Junior members are daughters of members who are 18 and under. They may not participate in WSCGA tournaments or team play.

Membership dues are complimentary.

What Does **Status** Mean?

Status is **not** the same as Member Types described above. When you look at a player's record, you will see the following codes indicating her **status** with your club:

A – Active (She is currently a paid member of your club, women's club and WSCGA; this does not mean she is a Regular member as she could be either a Junior or Handicap Only member.)

I – Inactive (She does not currently belong to your club.)

M – Multiple (She belongs to more than one club)

D – Multiple/Inactive (She has belonged to multiple clubs but is only active at one and is inactive at the other.)
