Club officers need only attend **ONE** meeting per year. The yearly calendar is published to accommodate members who may not be able to attend a meeting in their area.

HANDICAP CERTIFICATION SEMINAR

Handicap Certification Seminars are conducted by the WSCGA in order to comply with the USGA Handicap System Licensing Program. Handicap Chairpersons should be certified to comply with USGA Club Licensing requirements.

A club must have at least one member certified during each 4-year certification period in order to maintain its status as a licensed golf club.

Seminars include review of USGA handicap policies as well as WSCGA handicap procedures.

MEMBER LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP

Member Leadership Workshops are designed for those individuals holding office in their respective clubs. These workshops include Chairperson, Liaison, Tournament, Rules and Team Captains (when required).

It is important that each Chairperson attend or send a representative for the respective position. Club representatives are encouraged to take full advantage of the workshops, manuals, handouts and networking with other club representatives and the WSCGA Directors.

ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Members of the women's club must also be WSCGA members. WSCGA will provide a courtesy handicap index for any junior, 18 and under, playing from a WSCGA club.
2. Association dues: Membership dues for a 9- or 18-hole index is thirty dollars (\$30). The membership fee is due June 1 and delinquent June 30. Members belonging to more than one club must pay a separate fee for each club.

ADVANTAGES AND BENEFITS OF WSCGA MEMBERSHIP

COMPLETE HANDICAP SERVICE

WSCGA provides members with bimonthly handicap indices that are available at www.womensgolf.org. Services provided by GHIN include the following:

- GHIN Handicap Program (GHP) -- club handicapping software
- GHINClub.net (web player maintenance)
- Tournament Pairing Program (TPP)-(March 2011)
- eRevision -- Email with link to receive scoring history and new index
- eClubhouse -- Club managed websites for activities & tournaments (Summer 2011)

The WSCGA is available to assist the club Handicap Chairperson and provides clubs with complete handicap services including assistance in the installation of computer hardware and GHP software.

WSCGA offers Handicap Certification Seminars at various locations throughout Southern California. Member Leadership Workshops also include a breakout for Handicap Chairpersons.

USGA COURSE RATING SERVICE

The WSCGA provides members with complete course rating and review services in accordance with USGA standards. The WSCGA Course Rating Manager, captains and teams update course ratings every eight years. Ratings are reviewed and modified if a course undergoes substantial changes that would affect its rating, or if temporary conditions require a rating adjustment.

The Course Rating Manager is available to answer questions about the USGA Course Rating System.

TOURNAMENTS

Tournaments are planned for golfers of all handicap levels. All WSCGA tournaments are flighted with equal gross and net prizes awarded. Tournaments are divided into the following categories:

Major Tournaments with Perpetual Trophies:

Division I

Senior Championship
Mid-Winter Championship
Southern Championship
36-Hole Stroke Tournament
Tournament of Champions

Division II

Senior Championship
Jane Fortmiller Championship

Major tournaments generally accept the low 80-120 handicap entries.

Association Day Events-May be individual, partner, or 4-person events with a variety of formats.

Open Play Days-Four (4) Open Play Days are scheduled for 2010 in a variety of locations convenient for the majority of our members. These are tournaments open to all WSCGA members and provide an opportunity for members to play different golf courses with their friends in a low-key manner.

Open Play Days entry fees and forms as well as tournament information will be available online.

Saturday Play-Saturday golf is sponsored by the Women's Golf Council of Southern California and is for any female golfer with a verifiable USGA index.

Saturday Play entry fees and forms as well as tournament information will be available online.

RULES

The Rules Director and the Rules Education Committee (REC) are available to help with rules decisions at local and WSCGA-sponsored tournaments. The Rules Director is in close contact with USGA personnel for consultation. Clubs may request Rules Education Seminars to be held at member clubs and workshops for women's club Rules Chairpersons are held annually at Member Leadership Workshops.

TEAM PLAY

WSCGA sponsors annual team play for member clubs of both Division I and Division II.

CHAIRPERSON ASSISTANCE

The WSCGA does not make rules for the governance of member women's clubs but is available to help with questions regarding all facets of club activities. The WSCGA offers annual Member Leadership Workshops for Chairpersons and the WSCGA Liaison in an effort to help with clarification of WSCGA policies and procedures and to provide suggestions or ideas based on experiences in working with other member clubs.

MEMBER LEADERSHIP WORKSHOPS

Member Leadership Workshops are scheduled for Handicap, Rules, Tournament Chairpersons and Liaison. Participants are provided with manuals, WSCGA booklets and other documentation to assist them and are afforded an opportunity to network and exchange ideas with others in similar positions. (See calendar for dates.)

COMMUNICATIONS

The WSCGA Directory is revised annually and is available to all members. It contains a calendar of scheduled events and general information about the WSCGA policies and procedures, including team play and tournaments.

Tee Talk, a digital newsletter on the WSCGA website, contains up-to-date material about current activities, gives reports on tournaments, provides rules' information and serves as a channel to keep Association members informed.

OFFICE

The WSCGA Office is the focal point for all communications. Members may call during office hours to speak with the office personnel, or at any time with the voice mail system, leave a message for the office staff or individual Directors.

GUEST-DAY PRIVILEGES (DIVISION I)

Your WSCGA membership ensures your reciprocal Guest-Day privileges at member clubs without green fees.

OBLIGATIONS OF DIVISION I CLUBS AFFECTING ACCESS AND PLAY

This is a partial list of WSCGA member club's obligations. Please consult the WSCGA Bylaws for a comprehensive statement.

A member club is required:

1. To abide by all provisions of the Bylaws.
2. To insure proper handicap procedure and conduct competitive play in accordance with the **USGA Rules of Golf and USGA Handicap System**.
3. To maintain the golf course and member facilities in the best possible condition.
4. To notify the Association of any condition which impairs the course's suitability and/or availability for play.
5. To install and maintain permanent Rating Markers.
6. To avail its course for one (1) guest day a month for Association members, without green fees, for seventy-five percent (75%) of those months that the Club course is in operation each year.
7. To avail its course when requested for:
 - a. An Association Day Event.
 - b. One of the Major Tournaments for the Association, consisting of a qualifying round and three (3) days of match play in one week or one-two days of a two-day event.
 - c. WSCGA Team Play as necessitated by Team Play schedules.
8. To notify the Association as to any change of ownership or operational status of a member club.
9. To respect the following regarding WSCGA scheduled events:
 - a. There shall be no green fees (Division I only).
 - b. The course shall be reserved until the field has cleared the 1st tee.
 - c. To abide by the dress code: **NO ABBREVIATED ATTIRE**. Shorts and skirts are to be no shorter than five (5) inches above the center of the back of the knee; no halter tops, tank tops, etc. Tailored slacks are acceptable at many of the Clubs. **A Club's stricter dress code will take precedence.**
 - d. Most clubs allow non-metallic spikes or soft spikes only.
10. To consider the WSCGA Tournament Calendar when scheduling events, in an effort to encourage maximum participation in WSCGA Tournaments.

Term of one to four years

Attendance at board meetings each month and be available to attend committee meetings

Availability to "work" a certain number of tournaments each year

Any nominee should be aware of these requirements.

Upon receipt of the name, you (or the nominee) will be contacted. A resume of background information, references and an interview will be requested. A candidate for the Board is chosen, not only on her qualifications, but also on geographic location. The WSCGA Board consists of members representing all areas of Southern California.

2011 TEAM PLAY INFORMATION-- DIVISION I

1. There will be two tournaments in 2011: a Gross tournament and Net tournament. The format is Home and Home. Scoring and ties are explained in the 2011 Team Manual along with information pertaining to all matches, including the playoffs.
2. All matches shall be 4-ball match play with seven corresponding sides from each club competing against each other.
3. The handicap index limit is 30.0 based on a player's 12-month index average from February 15, 2010 to February 1, 2011.
4. Each player must meet the eligibility requirements as outlined in the Team Manual. Failure to do so shall result in loss of the entire team's points for that day and could also result in disqualification of the team.
5. The Group winners will compete in the Divisional Playoffs to determine the Divisional winners. All Divisional and Regional Playoff matches shall consist of 18 holes of golf. Further explanation is provided in the 2011 Team Manual.
6. Championship matches will be played on a Home and Home basis. Two Gross teams will be playing for the Gross Championship and two Net teams will be playing for the Net Championship.

TEAM PLAY INFORMATION -- DIVISION II

1. Team Play will be played in the month(s) as determined by the Team Committee and approved by the WSCGA Board of Directors.
2. WSCGA will hold organizational meetings prior to team play at which time Team Captains must submit a written statement regarding green fees and cart fees signed by their club management.
3. Team play will be Match Play with a Gross winner and a Net winner in each area within each region. All matches shall be 4-ball match play with four corresponding sides from each club.
4. Desert and Southern 2011 Division II Team Manuals will be available on the WSCGA website.

C. Rules for both **Major** and **Association Day Events**:

1. Entry Fee is listed by tournament in this book. The tournament fee for all two-day events is \$150, with the exception of the Executive Club Tournament, which is \$85. All one-day events are \$85. The tournament fees include an entry fee and club charges. **DO NOT SEND CASH.** There must be **one** check for each person entered. Send checks, payable to "WSCGA," with a properly completed WSCGA Entry Form to: ***WSCGA, 402 W. Arrow Hwy., Suite 10, San Dimas, CA, 91773.*** Online entry using American Express, MC and Visa is also available (nominal processing fee).
2. Entry Forms:
 - a. **Major Events and Association Days:** Entry Forms are available at your club and also can be printed from the WSCGA web site, www.womensgolf.org/wscga/tourney. Generic entry forms are also available in the WSCGA Directory.
 - b. For an Association Day Tournament involving a **single entry**, fill out only the top portion. **Partners Events:** Complete **BOTH** sections of the entry form.

In a **Partners Event** there is an eight-stroke handicap limitation spread **on the course being played at the time of play.** If the handicap spread on the course being played exceeds the maximum eight-stroke spread, the higher handicapped partner **MUST PLAY DOWN.** Full refunds will be given to those players who do not meet the entry criteria.

Rules Governing Tournaments (Continued)

3. Entries must not be received in the WSCGA office before the first day of entry. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries must be received in the WSCGA office no later than 4:00 p.m. on the last day of entry.
4. Competitors are notified by mail of starting times and other pertinent information approximately 3 weeks prior to an event. The Southern and Mid-Winter participants receive tee times via the website or by calling into the WSCGA office. Play lists will also be posted on the website.
5. Cancellations:
 - a. If you have to cancel, notify the WSCGA office at (909) 592-1281, extension 310 (cancellation line) or the Director-in-Charge. **Entry fees of \$20 (for one-day tournament) and \$40 (for two-day tournament) are nonrefundable after acceptance into tournament. NO REFUND OF ANY PORTION OF THE TOURNAMENT FEE WILL BE MADE AFTER THE CUT-OFF DATE LISTED IN THE TOURNAMENT INFORMATION.**
 - b. **Partners Events:** If one partner cancels after the entries have been accepted, a substitution may be made by the remaining partner with no additional fee by notifying the WSCGA office. The substitute player's handicap must stay as close as possible to the handicap of the original partner. Should the handicaps between partners be greater than 8 strokes, the higher handicap player must play down. If the remaining original partner must cancel, a team from the waiting list will be substituted. One of the original partners accepted into the event must remain as a participant in order for the team to remain as players. **No change in partners will be allowed after 3:00 p.m. on the Friday before the tournament. If your partner cancels after 3:00 p.m. on the Friday before the event, you will need to withdraw from the tournament, and a team from the Waiting List will be moved to the Playing List.**
 - c. **IF A TOURNAMENT IS CANCELLED BY WSCGA, YOUR CHECK WILL BE DESTROYED OR YOUR CREDIT CARD WILL BE REFUNDED.**
 - d. If a tournament site must be changed due to circumstances beyond the control of WSCGA, there will be no refund.
 - e. **DESERT EVENT ONLY -- No refund of any portion of the tournament fee after April 25.**

Rules Governing Tournaments (Continued)

6. A player who does not arrive to play, or who withdraws during a tournament for what is considered an unacceptable reason by the Tournament Committee, will forfeit any prize(s) and points earned during that tournament toward the State Team Competition. She will not be allowed to play in that tournament the following year. A player must report to the Director-in-Charge when withdrawing from a tournament.
7. Prizes: In all WSCGA-sponsored events, equal gross and net prizes are awarded. All ties are paid.
8. Priority: Gross and Net over-the-field, and 1st Gross and 1st Net flight winners qualify for automatic entry in that tournament the following year, provided they meet the index/handicap requirements. The following players qualify:

9. Eligibility: A member must be listed on the Member Club's handicap sheet prior to the entry dates and have a valid *USGA* Handicap Index, based on 20 rounds of golf.
 - a. **Major Events:** if oversubscribed, entries will be selected in lowest index order.

Rules Governing Tournaments (Continued)

- b. **Association Days (Division I & Division II):** USGA Handicap Index limit designated for each event. (**Indexes of 40.4+ are NOT eligible.**)

10. Red Flag Policy: WSCGA is in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and has set forth a procedure for the request of use of a medical flag in WSCGA competitions for anyone qualifying under the ADA (http://www.womensgolf.org/wscga/bulletins/pdf/08admin_06.pdf).
11. Caddies and Galleries: Caddies (unless required by the host club) or galleries are not allowed at any Association Day or Major Tournaments with the following exceptions: Caddies and galleries are permitted during the match play portion of the Mid-Winter, State Championship and Southern Championship. Neither caddies nor galleries are allowed in the stroke play qualifying round. Caddies must register at the check-in table each day. Caddies are required to walk and are prohibited from driving or riding in the player's cart at any time during the round. Spectators are required to stay on cart paths, where available, and are prohibited from walking on fairways and on or near putting greens.
12. All participants are required to use carts. The exception is that players may walk during the match play portion of the Mid-Winter, State and Southern, but must pay for the cart they do not use.
13. Only those players who are scheduled to play in the tournament, or who are notified by the WSCGA office or the Director-in-Charge, will be allowed to play. **No one arriving at the course on the day of an event will be allowed to play unless she has been previously notified.**

D. Additional Rules for **Major Tournaments:**

1. The field (either 80 or 120 players) for each major tournament is selected from the lowest indices of entries received.
2. Mid-Winter and Southern Qualifier: Player eligible to play on home course.

E. Additional Rules for **Association Days:**

1. Desert Event: Eligibility is based on entry month index. April 15 handicap index will be used for flighting and pairing.

2. Priority for Association Days will be given to a member who has entered two or more Association Day events during the past 12 months for which she was eligible but was not accepted. **The competitor must identify those events in which she was not accepted by attaching a note to the entry form.**
3. Host Club: A member is eligible to play her own Club.
4. Association Day: The selection of the field is determined by random draw.
5. Eligibility for Husband and Wife or Jack and Jill Tournaments: If oversubscribed, preference will be given to those who did not participate in the previous year's event. Preference will be given to unmarried couples in the Jack and Jill Tournament; married couples may play if event is undersubscribed. Preference will be given to married couples in the Husband and Wife Tournament; unmarried couples may play if event is undersubscribed. Men in both events must be members of WSCGA member clubs.

**LOCAL RULES
CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION**

The USGA Rules of Golf and Decisions govern WSCGA Tournament Play, and, where applicable, the following Local Rules and Conditions, plus any additional Local Rules as may be supplied at the tournament site. Unless otherwise specified, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Condition is two strokes in Stroke Play and loss of hole in Match Play.

1. **TIME OF STARTING.** The player shall start at the time laid down by the committee (**Rule 6-3**). The **Note to 6-3** is in effect.
2. **DRESS CODE.** Players must adhere to **WSCGA/Host Club Dress Code**. A player violating this Dress Code will not be permitted to start the competition. A player violating this Dress Code during the round will be **disqualified** from the competition.
3. **PACE OF PLAY.** A player shall be subject to penalty if she unduly delays play in accordance with any pace of play guidelines set down by the Committee. (**Rule 6-7**). **Note 2** under **Rule 6-7** is in effect as follows:

STROKE PLAY

1st Offense: One stroke

2nd Offense: Two strokes

Repeated Offense: Disqualification

MATCH PLAY

1st Offense: Loss of Hole

Repeated Offense: Disqualification

4. **DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE.** In **STROKE PLAY ONLY**, when a player is in doubt as to her procedure, she may play a “Second Ball” (**Rule 3-3**). The competitor must report the facts to the Committee before returning her scorecard; if she fails to do so, she will be disqualified.
5. **PERMANENT ELEVATED POWER LINES AND CABLES.** If a ball strikes a permanent elevated power line or cable on the course, it must be replayed, without penalty (see **Rule 20-5**). If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.
6. **EMBEDDED BALL THROUGH THE GREEN.** Local Rule as prescribed in the *USGA Rules of Golf, Appendix I*, shall be in effect.
7. **FLOWER BEDS** shall be treated as Ground under Repair (**Rule 25**) from which relief is mandatory.

Local Rules *(continued)*

8. **TREE BASINS.** There is no relief under the Rules from tree basins, which are not made of artificial materials (**Decision 33-2a/10.5**).
9. **SCORECARDS.** Scorecards must be returned to the Tournament Committee immediately upon completion of play.
10. **TIES.** In stroke play competition, unless stated otherwise, ties will be decided by matching scorecards over the back nine, back six, back three and 18th hole (**USGA Rules of Golf, Appendix 1**). In the case of a two-day competition, ties will be decided by matching second-day scorecards, using the above format.
11. **CELL PHONES AND AUDIBLE PAGERS.** The use of cell phones to give or receive advice is not allowed during the stipulated round of any WSCGA tournament. Additionally, repeated use of a cell phone on the golf course for any reason may constitute a serious breach of etiquette, which would result in a penalty of disqualification (**Rule 33-7**).
12. **DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES.** For this competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of **Rule 14-3**, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are usually used.
12. **RED FLAG POLICY.** WSCGA does not allow red flag privileges except where a player has applied to the WSCGA and has been granted exemption under the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Refer to the Position Statement at http://www.womensgolf.org/wscga/bulletins/pdf/08admin_6.pdf.
