- Course: Modified CWC Tees: Rating: - 75.0 Slope 127
- The dining room opens at 6:00 AM and the snack bar at 6:30AM.

STARTING

- Starting times begin at 8:00 **a.m.** on 1st tee and 10th tee in 10-minute intervals. In the event of rain, report to the clubhouse unless otherwise notified.
- Tee times for Monday will be posted online at <http://www.ghintpp.com/sdcwgagolf/TPPOnlineGolfer/default.aspx>. If you cannot get your time online, it is your responsibility to contact the CWC Coordinator at (619)368-5410, or the Temecula Creek pro shop (951) 506-1777
- Report to your assigned tee 10 minutes before starting time.
- Please have nametag on golf bag to facilitate handling.
- Practice Range: **6:30 a.m.** Complimentary range balls prior to round.

CHECK-IN

- Table in the plaza area near the pro shop Check-in will begin at 6:30 a.m.
- Outside service personnel will pick up the golf bags in the parking areas.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern all play except as modified by Local Rules as they appear on the CONDITIONS OF PLAY/LOCAL RULES.

PRACTICE ROUND

Practice round times have been reserved for Sunday from 12:30 to 2:30. Call the Pro Shop at (951) 506-1777. Mention CWC. CWC practice round yardages are available in Golf Shop. Note: Soft spikes only.

SCORING

- Exchange scorecard with fellow competitor.
- Pairings Tuesday and Wednesday by gross score.
- Return scorecard to scoring table immediately following play.

AWARDS

Champion, Runner-up and Eight Places – 3-day gross score determines winner. A tie for Champion will be broken by a 3-hole playoff. If still tied, then sudden death playoff. All other ties broken by applying the USGA back nine method beginning with the final round score. Awards presentation will be immediately after the Wednesday championship round.

PLAYERS' RECEPTION (included in entry fee)

- Please join your fellow competitors and the CWC Committee on Monday for no-host cocktails and hors d'oeuvres in one of the banquet rooms at approximately 2:30 p.m. (following play) for the Players' Reception.

AWARDS RECEPTION (included in entry fee)

- Pizza, salad and no-host cocktails in one of the banquet rooms at approximately 3 p.m. on Wednesday.

DRESS CODE

- Competitors, caddies and guests must abide by the dress code regulations set down by Temecula Creek Inn. Appropriate golf attire is required, e.g., shirts with collars (mock turtlenecks are permitted) and appropriate shorts, pants, or skirts (no cut-offs, gym shorts, tank tops or blue jeans). **SOFT SPIKES only.** *Participants are responsible for their purses and personal belongings.*

CARTS or CADDIES

- Cart fees are included in entry fee (limit 2 carts per group). Players are welcome to bring their own caddies. Caddies must be registered each day. Registration is at the Caddie check-in table in the plaza area near the pro shop. Caddies are expected to follow all guidelines as set down by the Committee. **Caddies must walk.**

CANCELLATION AND "NO SHOW" POLICIES

- Out of courtesy to your fellow competitors and the golf course, please plan to complete all three rounds. Players who do not comply with this commitment will be ineligible for the CWC in 2012.
- Any player who must withdraw their entry prior to **July 8**, will have their entry fee refunded minus \$50. Any player who cancels after this date is responsible for the championship charges.
- **"NO SHOWS" will result in a 2-year suspension from the CWC.**

GALLERY

- **A walking** gallery is welcome but must walk on the cart paths only.

RESTROOMS

Creek course # 5 Tee/#8 green, Oak course just past # 3 Green, and behind the snack bar at the turn.
