North / South Team Matches – Match Play Format

HOLES 1-6: FOUR BALL

Two (2) players from one Association are teamed as partners against two (2) players from the opposing Association. All players play their own ball. On each hole, the better gross score of the two counts as the team's score for that hole.

HOLES 7-12: MODIFIED SCOTCH

On the 7th tee the players of each team decide who will hit their tee shot on even holes and who will hit their tee shot on odd holes. The team then plays alternate shots from there until the ball is holed. The alternate shot continues throughout the six (6) holes.

HOLES 13-18: TWO-PERSON SCRAMBLE

Both players from each team hit a tee shot. The team then selects which tee shot to play. Both members of the team then hit a ball from that position and again select the shot from which to play. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed.

Each team member must hit a minimum of two (2) tee shots for the six (6) holes.

Each team member may place her ball within one club length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole. If the selected shot is played from a hazard, bunker, rough, second cut, fairway or fringe of the green, the ball may be placed within one club length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole, but it must remain in the hazard, bunker, rough, etc.

When putting, the ball must be placed within one (1) putter head length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole.

PUTTS can be conceded in any of the formats.

POINTS / SCORING:

One (1) point is awarded for each format and one point (1) is awarded for the most total hole points won over the 18 holes. A total of four (4) points are available per match. Twelve (12) points (4 per match x 3 matches) are available for the whole contest.
